98/18 CORNWALL COUNCILLOR

Cllr German reported that the Roseland were being considered as the pilot area for Cornwall Council's Environmental Growth Strategy.

Cllr Giles asked about the recycling of black plastic pots, however, according to Cllr German they cannot be recycled at present. Cllr German thought the Roseland Garden Centre would be happy to take them.

Cllr Giles asked regarding the difference between holiday lets and second homes in how waste is collected. Cllr German stated that holiday lets being a business should have a waste transfer licence.

99/18 MINUTES OF THE LAST ORDINARY COUNCIL MEETING OF 6th JUNE 2018

Cllr Pring proposed, seconded by Cllr Farr and the Council **resolved** that the minutes were a true and accurate record of the previous meeting.

100/18 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

Per 86/18 an initial meeting regarding the proposed Emergency Plan would take place in September due to forthcoming holidays.

101/18 CORRESPONDENCE

102/18 HIGHWAYS AND PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

Cllr Egerton wrote to neighbouring parishes regarding his desire using Community Network Panel funding to address issues on the Probus bypass. He seeks a speed reduction from 60mph to 50mph and average speed cameras.

No resolution was forthcoming at this stage, however, the Clerk would report back the general feeling of Council would be to support his proposal in principle but not a reduction to

50mph over all of the road. The Council feel that more speed enforcement is necessary and should be raised at the next community police meeting.

The Chair reported that he had met with Adrian Hosking from Cornwall Council regarding the various highway issues and suggested placing circular 30mph signs on the road as opposed to 'slow' signs at both ends of the Ruan Lanihorne village.

## 103/18 FINGERPOST SIGNS

The Clerk reported that he had made contact with Viv Bidgood regarding fingerpost maintenance. They are not considered part of highway signage, however, Cormac may be able to assist given their historic status. Viv Bidgood requested photographs of the fingerposts to access their condition in the first instance.

Cllr Giles volunteered to take the photographs.
